<u>Recency requirement:</u> BIOL 20 Human Anatomy, BIOL 22 Physiology, and Chemistry or Physics must be completed within 8 years of the application period; end of summer 2016 for February 2025 applications.

All applicable courses must be completed by the end of the Fall Semester 2024.

All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. ("C-"is not accepted.)

In order to apply to the program, the minimum degree applicable GPA is 2.80.

Continuous Attendance/Catalog Rights: The general education requirements apply to students during the 2024-2025 school year. Students who enrolled at Chaffey prior to Fall 2024 and who have maintained continuous attendance (attendance in at least one semester or two quarters, excluding summer sessions, each calendar year — January 1 through December 31 — as indicated on a permanent record) at any accredited college, have the option of meeting the current general education requirements or those in effect at the time continuous attendance at Chaffey began. IT IS IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW ALL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS on the website.

- The application must be current, signed and submitted electronically. See the RadTec website for instructions.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- The RadTec Transcript Evaluation form must be included with the application.
- The point system on the reverse side is provided to aid students in planning their courses prior to applying to the RadTec program and is subject to change by the department without notification.

Points will only be counted from courses completed from a regionally accredited institution in the United States. Foreign coursework will not be considered.

<u>Applications</u> will be <u>ranked according to points</u> earned for coursework completed through the Fall term preceding the application period. Ties in points are broken on the basis of degree applicable GPA. The minimum degree applicable GPA to apply to the program is 2.80.

ADDITIONAL POINTS:

- Consideration for one additional point may be awarded for paid prior acute care
 hospital experience with sufficient verification. The point for work experience is not guaranteed
 until verified by the application committee. See website: 500 hours of direct patient
 care experience must be completed within the last 5 years. Direct patient care is the care of
 a patient providing personal "hands-on" contact with patients in an acute care hospital. The
 acute care hospital must have an emergency room, ICU and surgical departments.
- Consideration for additional one point will be given to applicants with a current California
 Limited Permit in Radiologic Technology. A copy of the current permit(s) must be
 submitted with application. The point for work experience is not guaranteed until verified by
 the coordinators.
- Consideration for one additional point will be given to veterans who have been honorably discharged and meet the RT program admissions criteria. Military service documentation must be submitted with the application. Acceptable documentation includes a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214C) or a Proof of Service Letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
- Students will have 1 attempt to apply for additional points. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Refer to the RT Information Packet for instructions.

The <u>top 50</u> applicants will be **required** to attend a RadTec Information Session. The <u>top 28 and 22 alternate</u> applicants will be required to obtain a certificate of successfully passing a background check from an approved vendor(s). Refer to the RadTec website for details and for the most current information.
