All San Bernardino County residents who 16-years-old or older are now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine at one of the county-run vaccination sites:

The article stated that:

"Residents ages 16 and 17 can only receive the Pfizer vaccine and therefore can only be served at San Bernardino County Public Health sites and state OptumServe sites. They will also need to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to receive the Pfizer vaccine, according to the county."
