VALIDATING a prerequisite

Students who have met the prerequisite through successful completion of prerequisite requirements, can validate the prerequisite by completing the "Validation" process. This can be done by successful completion of the prerequisite course (or requirement) at another accredited college, successful passing of an Advanced Placement (AP) exam, or successful completion of high school coursework (if applicable).

STEPS:

- Electronically submit *official* high school transcripts, external college transcripts, or College Board AP scores to the Admissions and Records Office
- Submit a [Prerequisite/Corequisite Clearance Form](#)

For students who have not met the prerequisite

CHALLENGING a prerequisite

Students who believe they have the knowledge or ability to succeed in a course, but are not able to validate that they meet the prerequisite requirements, can request to have the prerequisite waived by successfully completing the "Challenge" process.

STEPS:

- Electronically submit *official* high school transcripts, external college transcripts, or College Board AP scores to the Admissions and Records Office
