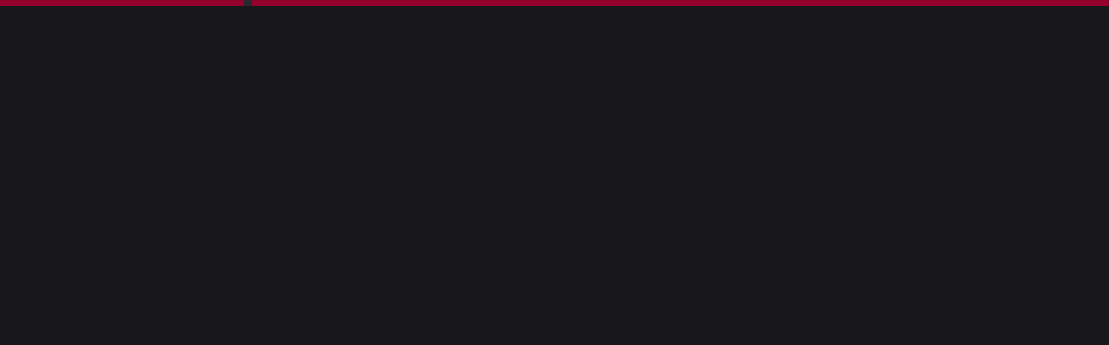




# Apply for or renew a high school articulation agreement

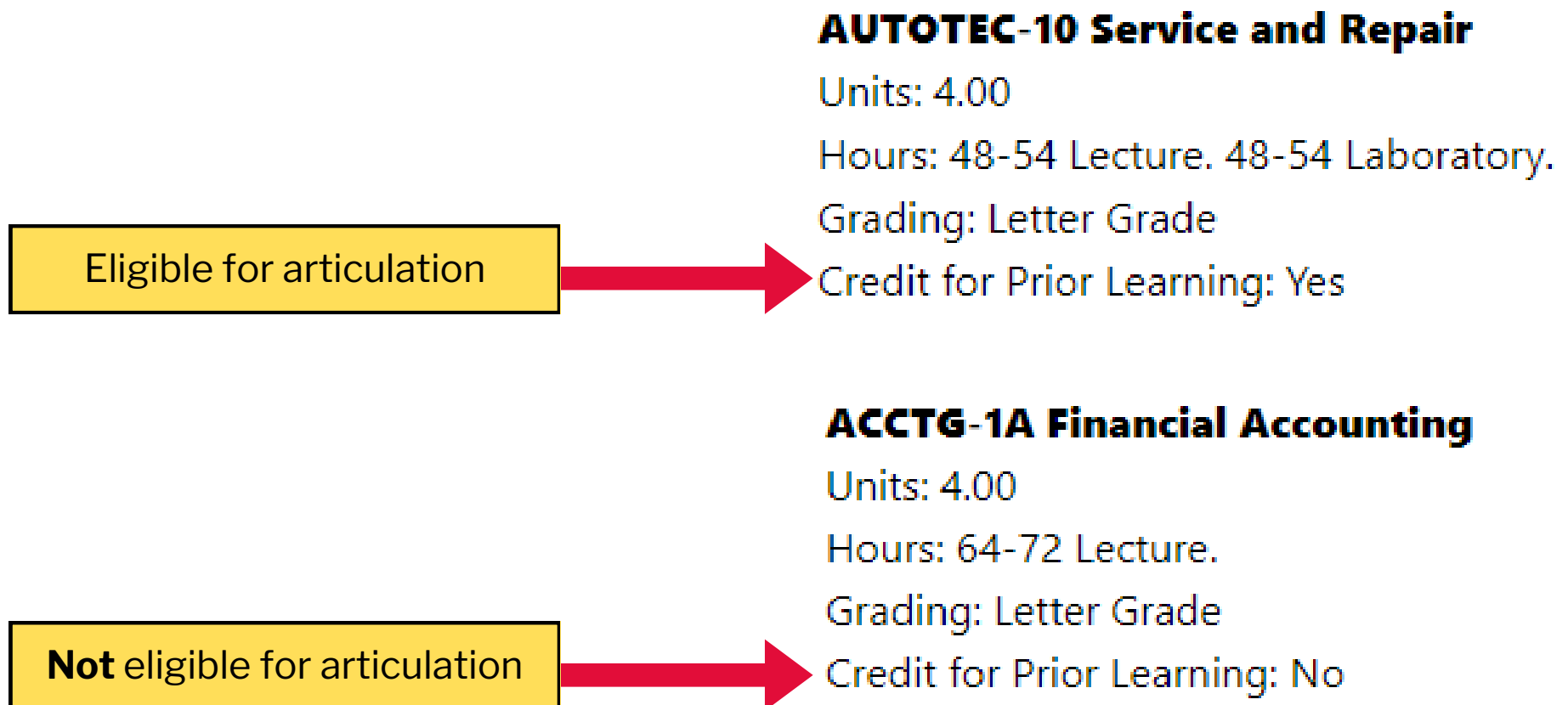
High School Articulation





# Step 1: Verify course eligibility


- Not all classes at Chaffey are eligible for high school articulation.
- Search the current [course catalog](#) for the college course you're seeking to articulate with and look for:
  - **Credit for Prior Learning: Yes**





# Step 2: Complete the application

- Complete required fields and upload materials on the form
- If approved, agreements will be valid for 2 years, as measured by fall/spring academic terms
- Apply during the current application window listed on the Chaffey HS Articulation website



There will be 3 levels of review at Chaffey

- You'll receive email notifications with which step the review process is in.

## Three possible outcomes:

- **Approved:** Set up CATEMA account (how-to guide on the Chaffey hs articulation website)
- **Needs modification:** You will have a chance to edit your application. If it's rejected you will have to reapply.
- **Rejected:** You will have to submit a new application.
