9. UNFINISHED BUSINESS *10 minutes max

- **9.1 Action Item/Second Read:** Develop Academic Senate recommendations for Rising Scholars and Turning Point programs
- Motion for Approval Vice President Encarnacion moved to have Academic Senate involvement in the advisory committee for Turning Point and Rising Scholars. Senator Holdiness seconded the motion. The motion was approved. 10.10.23, 21Y/0N/0A
- Senator Jenkins requested clarification on the advisory committee's involvement. President DeRose pointed to last week's packet and read the advisory committee description. There are three current Academic Senators on the committee. Vice President Encarnacion amended the motion to add that there be intentional reporting back to the Academic Senate. Senator Hijaz announced that Michelle Martinez was removed from the FOSA. Senator Lee shared that, in the email from Alisha Rosas to faculty teaching in the Turning Point program, if faculty need anything then reach out to Alisha Rosas as the point person. Various Senators asked questions surrounding the Turning Point FOSA. Senator Hijaz asked for clarification on who to reach out to for questions, stating she used to reach out to Michelle Martinez, and asked if Rob Rundquist was still a point person. Guest Rosas clarified that she was the Administrative point of contact going forward. Guest Rosas stated they will re-fly the FOSA for Turning Point. Senator Lee asked if the current student cohorts will finish. Guest Rosas replied yes. Senator Johnson asked if maybe a FOSA is not the right model for those programs. Guest Rosas said it will fly as a FOSA but with different support. Senator Bobove asked for the vision of the program. Guest Rosas replied that the vision is to mend the relationship with the programs. They also want to talk with the students to make improvements. Guest Rosas explained that the program is not working well and is currently under restructuring. This will not work without faculty. Even though it is housed in Student Services there will be involvement with instruction. Senator Hijaz emphasized restructuring the FOSA to dedicate more faculty time. For example, if you are an Instructional Specialist, you can't run the success center at 50%. Vice President Encarnacion suggests an instructional coordinator or full-time faculty role. Guest Burruel reminded everyone that counseling faculty have been the leaders thus far. Moving forward, there needs to be a larger support team. Onboarding of students requires Student Services. Vice President Encarnacion expressed the need for involvement from both Student Services and Instruction to be 50-50. Guest Burruel said the office of instruction will continue to support these programs, help solve the structural issues, and activate the Advisory Group. President DeRose brought it back to the motion and asked if we want representatives beyond the three from the Academic Senate, periodically report back to the Academic Senate, and requested to have faculty involvement in the selection in FOSA hiring.
- **9.2 Action Item/Second Read:** DEI workgroup to lead efforts on institutional definitions for equity terminology in partnership with other committees/entities on campus.
- Motion for Approval Vice President Encarnacion moved to approve the DEI workgroup to lead
 efforts on institutional definitions for equity terminology in partnership with other committees/entities
 on campus. Senator Holdiness seconded the motion. The motion was approved. 10.10.23, 20Y/0N/1A
- Senator Ming emailed Tomeka Carter and Albert Rodriquez asking about institutional definitions. They
 replied with the request to allow them time to discuss and will get back to Senator Ming. Vice President
 Encarnacion said that the Academic Senate can provide suggestions outside the purview of specific
 departments/programs. Senator Chamberlain added that this is an Academic Senate issue because it is
 very important to academic matters. Curriculum Chair Burk Herrick said that there is a precedent to

have several groups work toward a common goal. President DeRose shared at the ASCCC/ACCJC Accreditation Institute 2023 that anti-racism is being put in Accreditation.

10. NEW BUSINESS *10 minutes max per item

- 10.1 Discussion Item/First Read: Formation of an Academic Senate workgroup charged with the development of faculty resources to more thoroughly understand Artificial Intelligence (AI), respond to its impacts on their teaching, and engage with students on the best use of these tools in their disciplines. The workgroup would work with other constituent groups as necessary, and present recommendations to the Academic Senate for consideration no later than November 14, 2023. (See September 12 meeting minutes)
 - Motion for Discussion Vice President Encarnacion moved to discuss the formation of an Academic Senate workgroup charged with the development of faculty resources to more thoroughly understand Artificial Intelligence (AI). Senator Boboye seconded the motion.
 - Senator Lee added that the Distance Education (DE) Committee is involved in AI practices so this committee should partner with DE. Vice President Encarnacion added that the student government should be involved as well since this impacts students. Senator Henry added that KNA met with Angela Cardinale which was really helpful since Angela shared resources and best practices. Senator Boboye reminded everyone of the webinar on November 7 titled "Regenerative AI As A Tool for Teaching and Learning." Senator Lee says DE Coaches are meeting with individual departments to help develop AI department-specific resources. Senator Overduin suggests maybe we could develop a Senate resolution.
