10. NEW BUSINESS *10 minutes max per item

10.1 Action Item: Identification of an Academic Senate appointed faculty member to serve on the [Calendar Committee](#).

- Senator DePonte volunteered to serve on the Calendar Committee.
- **Motion for Approval** - Curriculum Chair Burk Herrick moved to endorse the identified Academic Senate appointed faculty to serve on the Calendar Committee. Senator Boboye seconded the motion. The motion was approved. 10.24.23, 19Y/0N/0A.

10.2 Discussion Item/First Read: Campus Culture

- Vice President Encarnacion emailed Jon from CCFA today and will report back to the Academic Senate.
- Curriculum Chair Burk Herrick reminded the Academic Senate about the Vice President's Report last week on the culture of fear. Curriculum Chair Burk Herrick shared her concern about faculty being afraid to bring items to the Academic Senate because it interferes with Academic Senate's ability to function as it should. She also stated her opinion that participatory governance makes us better as an institution, so how faculty address this moving forward is important. It is unfortunate that some classified professionals feel similarly. She also reminded the Academic Senate that the AP 2510 Workgroup was established as a way to work towards a renewed commitment to participatory governance across campus.
- President DeRose encouraged the expansion of the AP 2510 Workgroup to include members of the Classified Senate and CCSG.
- Senator Johnson reiterated from the last meeting the need for a safe space and the need to implement action items for improvement; AP 2510 Workgroup is just one of these needed action items. In her experience, faculty have served on committees and made recommendations that went nowhere.

- Senator Holdiness added that perception needs to be addressed. Culture perpetuates perception and the safe space needs to be a brave space as well.
- Senator Chamberlain shared that tenure is a responsibility more than a right. The privilege of tenure allows faculty to speak up and be brave.
- Senator Jenkins added concerns about loss of faculty spaces.
- Senator Henry added that, in her opinion, deans are being spread too thin which interferes with efforts in visionary work and building community. Deans having too much responsibility has led to more responsibility being put on coordinators.
- Senator Boboye asked what is next, what is our action plan?
- President DeRose responded that we will return to this discussion in a future meeting. Next week's agenda will include a visit from Associate Superintendent/President Henry Shannon.
- **Motion to Discuss** - Curriculum Chair Burk Herrick moved to discuss Campus Culture. Senator Johnson seconded the motion.

10.3 Academic Senate Training Item: [Sabbatical Proposal Guidelines and Rubric](#) (in preparation to review sabbatical proposals)

- We have received eleven sabbatical proposals! If each one of us reads one sabbatical proposal then no one will have to read two!
- President DeRose led the senators through a brief overview of the sabbatical process with an emphasis on training the Academic Senate for the upcoming proposal evaluations.
- The Senate discussed how the Sabbatical Reports can be housed in the future.
