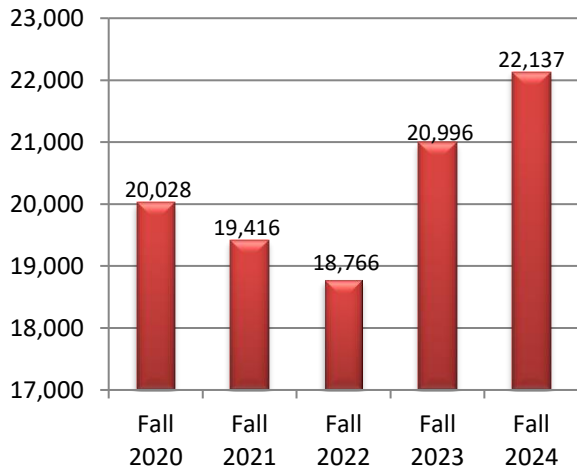

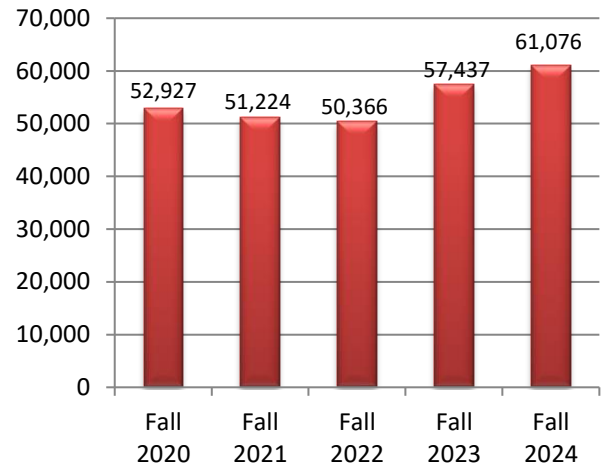
### Unduplicated Student Headcount



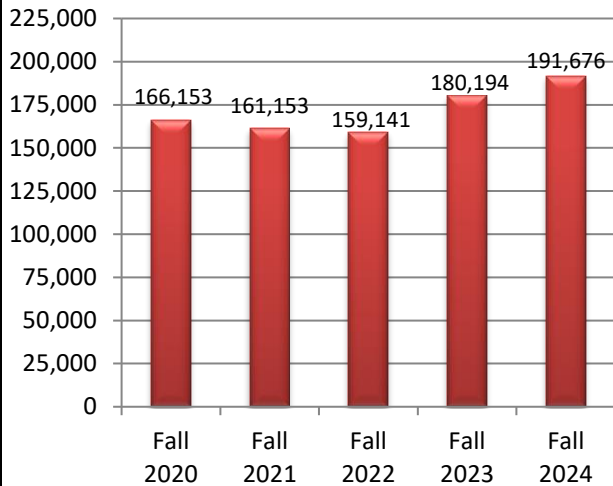
← 1,141 more credit students than last fall (+5.4%).

### Number of Credit Enrollments



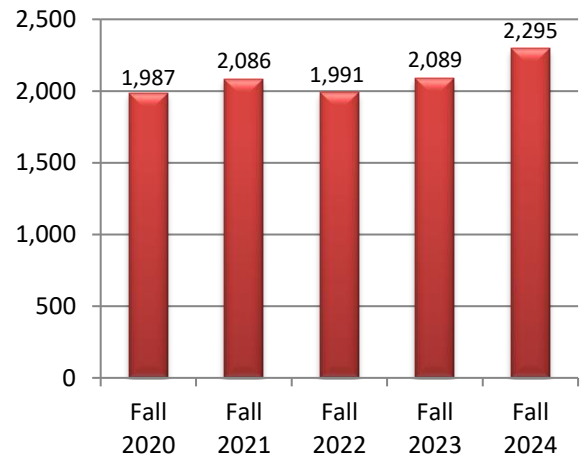
### Total Credit Units Attempted



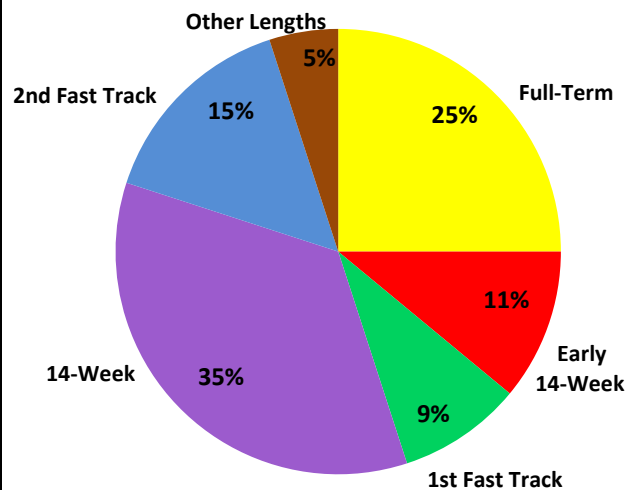
← 11,482 more units attempted by students than last fall (+6.4%).

### Number of Credit Sections Offered

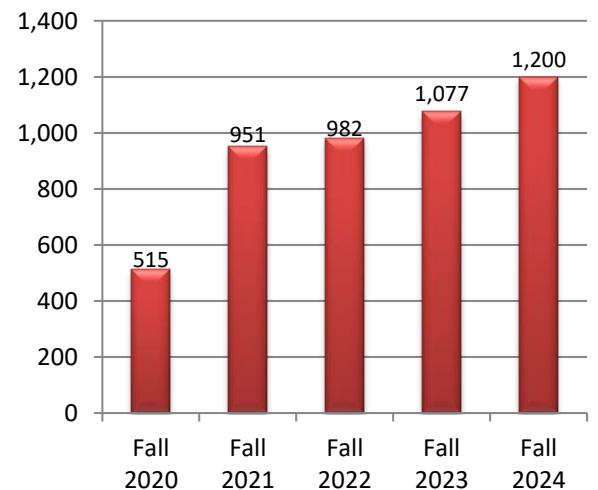


### Section Distribution by Session Length



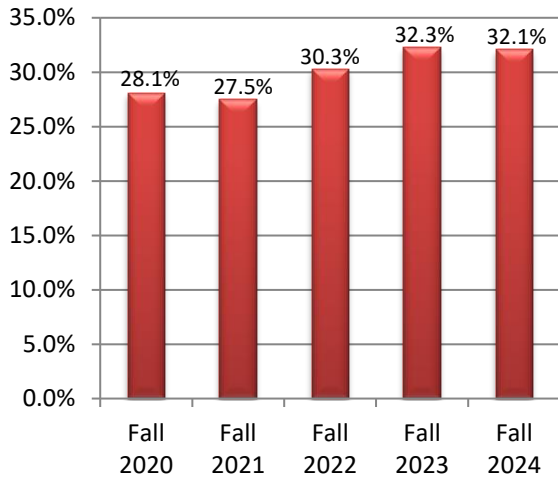

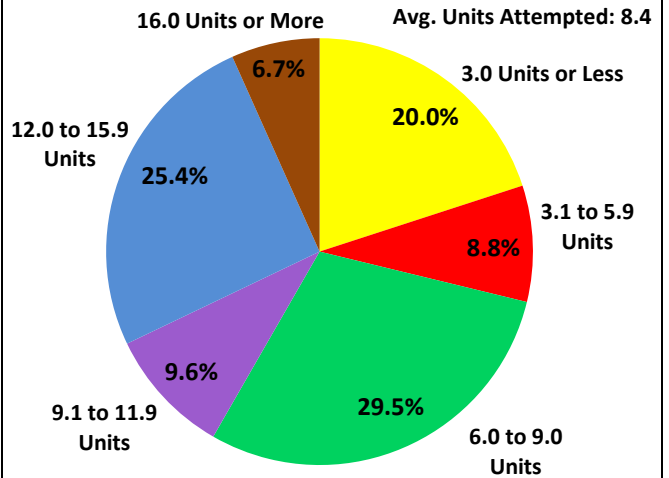
### Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



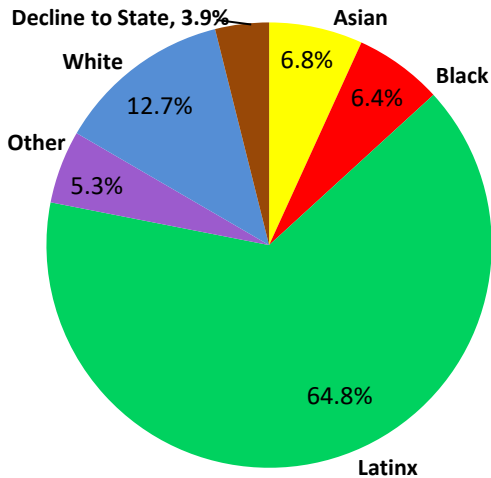
← The number of full-time students has remained relatively constant since last fall.

### Units Attempted, Fall 2024



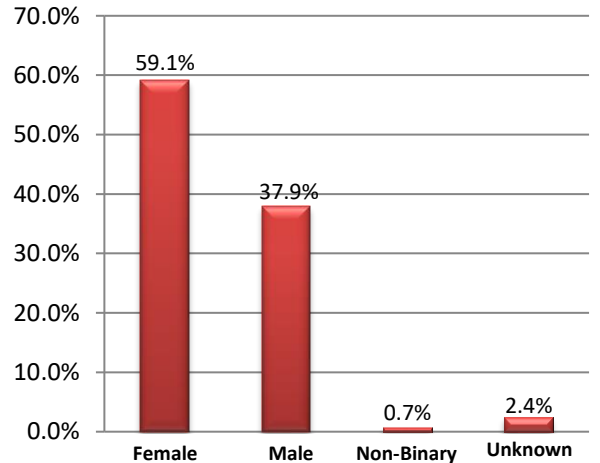
### Student Ethnicity



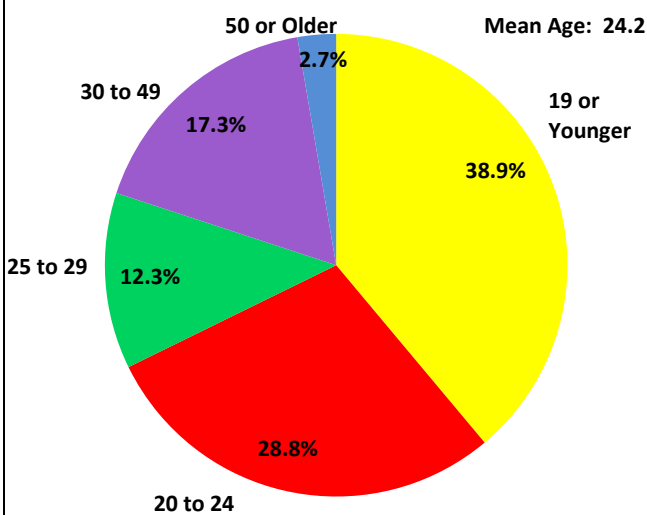
← 83.4% of students are from historically under-represented student populations, (last fall: 83.9%).
