Career and Technical Education Employment Outcomes Survey (CTEOS)

Overview: The Office of Institutional Research collaborates with Santa Rosa Junior College annually to assess employment outcomes of students who have participated in Career and Technical Education (CTE) coursework at Chaffey College. The survey addresses student perceptions of their CTE program, employment outcomes, and how their coursework and training relate to their current career. The data below displays averages from 2017 through 2022. On average, 633 students annually responded to the survey (32.1% of students surveyed).

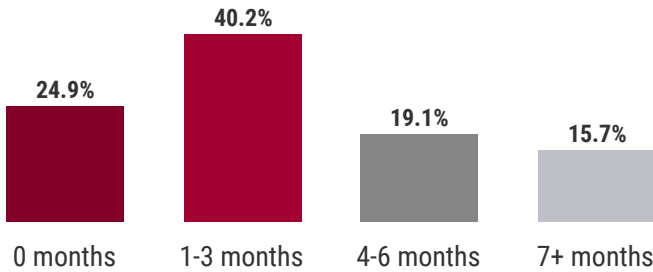

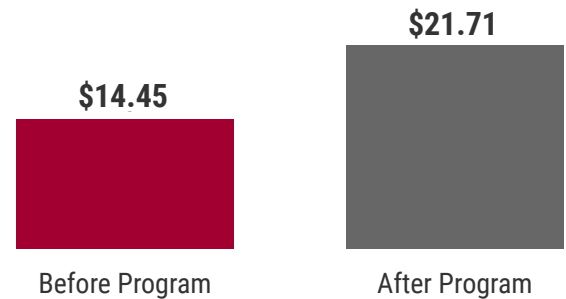

On average, students who gained employment in a field that is closely aligned to their program of study earned \$7.00 more (hourly) after earning their award (degree and/or certificate). Students who gained employment in a field that is not closely aligned to their program of study earned an average of \$2.00 more (hourly) post award.
