## Student Basic Need Insecurities (BNI) - Spring 2023 Semester

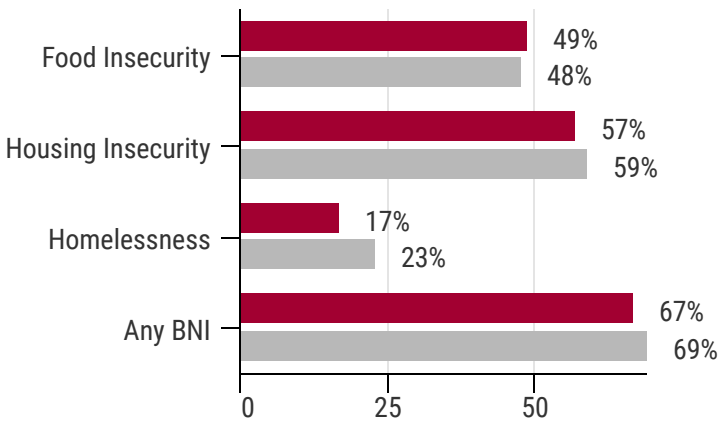
Overview: In the spring 2023 semester Chaffey College participated in two surveys designed to identify the level of basic need insecurities (BNI) among students: 1) the 2023 Student Basic Needs Survey, a nationwide survey conducted thru The Hope Center for College, Community, and Justice at Temple University (998 valid survey responses received); and 2) the 2023 #RealCollegeCalifornia Survey, a statewide survey conducted by the Research & Planning (RP) Group on behalf of the Community College League of California (CCLC) Real College California Coalition (2,287 valid survey responses received). Both surveys were disseminated to all students who were actively enrolled in the spring 2023 semester. The number of valid responses recorded for each survey affords the college the opportunity to generalize findings to the entire spring 2023 student population (19,971 students) with approximately a 99.8% confidence level (margin of error approx. 1.93% - 3.06%). Furthermore, these two independent surveys provide very similar profiles of basic need insecurities that exist among Chaffey College students.

● Responses from #RealCaliforniaCollege Survey

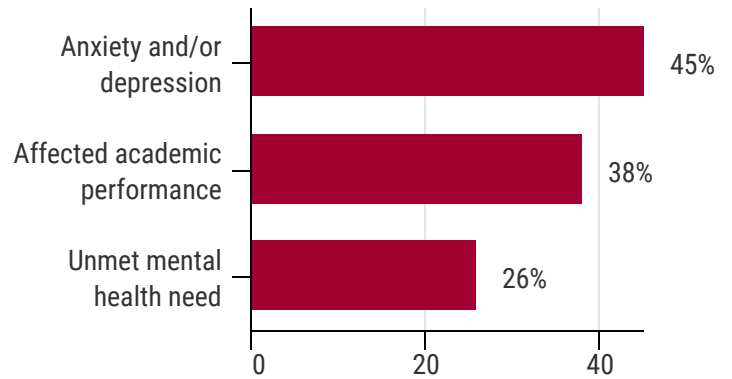
### Type of BNI Experienced

Food Insecurity assessed over the past month; all other insecurities assessed over the past year

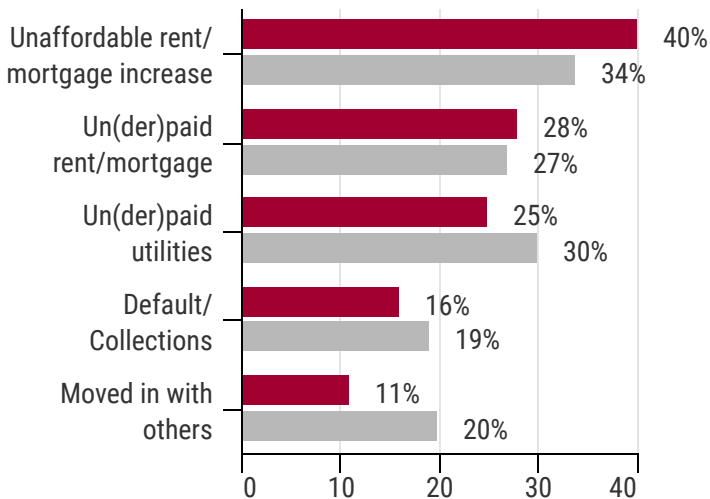


### Mental Health Challenges
