This is a free event that is open to the community. Sonia stated, "I know it sounds cheap but to make the candy stretch, limit it to one piece per person." Discussion continued.

New Club Charter Request:

Sonia emailed the link to all ICC representatives which was indicated on the agenda and asked them to cast their vote for the Chemistry Club and Muslim Students Association after she shared a brief description of each club. An officer for the Chemistry Club was present and spoke about the club.

- Chemistry Club 27 clubs: 16 Yes, 1 No, 10 abstained
- Muslim Students Association 27 clubs: 16 Yes, 1 No, 10 abstained

<u>Fundraising:</u> Sonia reminded everyone that cash is the only acceptable means of payment. Chaffey does not accept Zelle, Venmo or other online cash payments. Accounting Services is working with their bank in hopes that maybe there will be an online means for student clubs.

<u>Club Minutes:</u> Sonia stated that when taking attendance, spell out the officer's name, can be first name only, and then place next to their name is they are absent (A) or present (P). Make sure that the amounts match that are on the minutes with the funding request. Example: there was discussion of purchasing \$100 of candy for Trunk or Treat. So and so motioned and so and so seconded, then call for a vote. But the funding request is for \$125. Sonia can only process what is indicated in the minutes.

Club Reports:

Sonia reminded everyone that club reports must be submitted online the Wednesday, prior to the next scheduled ICC meeting no later than 2pm.

Sonia reminded those in attendance that ICC meetings are mandatory. Is the Trunk Or Treat link also for individuals going to the event? No, individuals do not need to sign up to attend.

Do you want requests for Trunk Or Treat? The registration works if the club did not submit an event proposal that is ok for this event.
